PREFACE:

Barpeta Girls' College was established on 7th September, 1978 with a view to spreading the light of higher education among the women folk of the District. Barpeta Girls' College is the pioneer institution for Girls' Education in Barpeta District of Assam. From the very beginning some eminent personalities headed by Late Nibaran Chandra Choudhury have been relentlessly trying to keep this institution alive by dedicating themselves in all sorts of ways. This college has been imparting higher education for the last 40 years among girls' coming from every nook and corner of the district.

After crossing many hurdles the college attained the status of Deficit-Grant- in-Aid on 25th March, 1998. The college was assessed and accredited by NAAC peer team in the year 2004 and 2016 respectively. 5th January, 2007 was a remarkable day in the history of the college, because on that very day the college was registered under section 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956.

We humbly pay our gratitude to all those who have left no stone unturned to make this institution a success and hope that the people of Barpeta will surely extend their love and co-operation to this institution to make it a centre of excellence.

LOCATION:

Historically famous and locally known as "Hati reserve" is the location of the college. It is situated in the "Satra Nagari" Barpeta. The college has 7 acres of landed property. The Govt. of Assarn vide its letter No: KARAP-5/28/79/62 dated 18/06/1979 (Revenue Deptt.) has allotted 20B-OK-OL land to the college under Dag No.1 (Part-I) of Barpeta town under Mauza Budarurtup, Barpeta.

CENTRAL LIBRARY:

The Central Library of the college is partially computerised and it has a collection of more than 14,000 books including text, references and other documents. It subscribes several vernacular and English Dailies, weeklies, fortnightly and monthly journals and magazines suited to the tastes and needs of both the students and teachers. The Library has 6 (six) encyclopedias in deferent subjects. It has a special collection of popular old Assamese Magazines. Besides the Library acquired some rare books on the life and works of Mahatma Gandhi.

All students and employees of the college are free to have an access to the Library facilities. Besides students reading room, the Library has also a separate reading room for the staff. At least 50 students can read at a time in the reading room. It has reprographic, book bank and internet facilities. The Library is going to setup a Digital Library this year.

LIBRARY HOURS:

The Central Library remains open from 9.30A.M. to 4.00 P.M. on all working days.

LIBRARY RULES:

- 1. Three Books will be issued at a time to every students (Gen. & Major)
- 2. Only text books will be issued on loan.
- 3. Reference books will not be issued on loan.
- 4. Books will be issued to the students from 11-00 A.M. to 3-00 P.M. on the basis of availability of books.
- 5. The Borrower must return the book within 15 days Otherwise a fine of Rs. 5(five) will be levied for each day for the next 15 days, and one rupee for each day thereafter against each book.
- 6. Before declaration of the result of General Test Examinations of the college, students must return the books.
- 7. Borrowers must satisfy themselves about the physical condition of the book before borrowing.
- 8. Books lost or defaced or injured in any way shall have to be replaced by the borrower, if fails then twice of the market value of the same will have to pay.



N.S.S. Unit:

The N.S.S. unit of the college was brought into existence in the year 2004. At the initial stage the unit had only 125 student members but now more students are showing their interest in N.S.S. and for that very reason, the number of members have increased rapidly. From the beginning of the N.S.S. unit, it has undertaken several programmes like- Campus Cleaning drive, World Environment Day, Free Health Camp, and Campus Beautification Programme, Women Empowerman Programme etc.

SCOUT & GUIDE UNIT:

The Scout & Guide unit was opened in the year 2003 with a view to provide social services in the vicinity of Barpeta Town and its neighbouring villages.

COMPUTER EDUCATION: (Centre for Information and Communication Technology (CICT)

The Institute of Computer Education, Barpeta Girls' College, Barpeta was established in the year 2003 as a self financing institute. The main objective of the institute is to acquaint the students with basic knowledge of computer science and to train the students for self-employment in various computer related works. The institute offers certificate on various courses of computer application.

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

The aim of a college is no longer confined to classroom teaching alone. The corpus of a modern college comprises extension-education too. Barpeta Girls' College in its endeavour to merge as an ideal center of learning has given due stress on extension activities and proposes to undertake the following programmes.

- b. Social work by NSS unit.
- c. National level seminer/conference will be conducted.
- d. Health care programme by Red Ribbon Club.

ACADEMIC REGULATION:

Admission Procedure:

Application for admission into all the classes begins with the notification issued by the Principal immediately after the announcement of the result of the respective examination and the Prospectus for admission can be obtained from the college office on payment of the prescribed fees and the intending candidates are required to submit the completed application form within the prescribed time. Applications will be processed and finalized by the "Admission Committee". The list of selected candidates will be displayed in the office as per notification and the selected candidates will have to get themselves admitted accordingly, failing of which shall lead to the cancellation of the seat. Admission Form enclosed herewith completed and submitted within prescribed time along with the following documents:

- 1. Attested copies of all certificates and mark sheets.
- 2. Character Certificate from the Head of the Institute attended last.
- 3. HSLC Admit Card for verification of age.
- 4. Certificate of SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/PH/OSP.
- 5. Gape Certificate from a competent authority if required.
- 6. Two passport size photographs.



Eligibility Norms:

The eligibility norms for submission of application for admission into the various courses will be as under:

- 1. H.S. (Arts) Courses: H.S.L.C or equivalent recognized examination passed.
- 2. H.S. (Commerce) courses: HSLC or equivalent recognised examination passed.
- 3. B.A. 1st Semester (Arts) Courses: H.S (Arts) or equivalent recognized examination passed for general course and at least 45% marks for Major course.
- 4. B. Corn 1St Semester (Commerce Course): H.S. (Com.) examination passed.

Reservation of Seats:

Seats will remain reserved subject to the avilability of applications in the following order:

- 1. S.C- 15%
- 2. S.T(plain)- 8%
- 3. S.T(hills)- 6%
- 4. O.B.C. and M.O.B.C- 10%
- 5. Physically handicapped- 3%

Relaxation of Marks:

Candidates eligible for reservation shall be given relaxation up to 5% of the marks. Those who have outstanding qualities at national, state or varsity level may be offered a few seats for admission into various courses subject to the availability of seats.

Registration and Migration:

Registration is compulsory for all students on submission of prescribed form after admission under AHSEC or GU. and students from Boards or University other than SEBA, AHSEC or GU. shall have to produce Migration Certificate at the time of admission.



Attendance:

Attendance is compulsory in all classes. Students shall be required at least 75% of attendance of lectures for all classes to become eligible to sit for the final examination, if not she will be disqualified for the same or principal may take any action against such student.

Cancellation of Seats:

A student failing to attend classes for thirty days at a stretch shall forfeit her seat.

Examination Rules:

- All regular students will have to appear both unit test, sessional examination & pre final examinations.
- 30% marks obtained in the unit test and 30% marks obtained in the pre final examination will be counted or decisions of academic committee will be considered for final selection to appear in the final examinations.
- Medical certificate, if any for not being able to appear in both the internal examinations must be produced at the time of examination.

Syllabus and Course Structure under Semester System:

- The Syllabus for each paper should be divided into modules or units. Each unit should be assigned marks (Preferably equal marks for each unit) so that the question paper of the final semester examination cover the entire syllabus.
- The minimum total marks in a under graduate course should be (preferably) in between 2400-3000. Due to different nature of subjects with practical or otherwise, the individual stream may make the final decision regarding the total marks.
- In the Sixth Semester there must be at least one paper where the students are given the opportunity to apply their knowledge. The course may be so designed that students creativity is encouraged. This could be a small academic project', an advanced level practical work including literature survey on a topic, field/survey work or any other work which may induce creativity among the students. The students must submit two copies of the Project Work prepared in the format of a Ph. D. or M. Phil. thesis. The student will have to define the work before an external examination and internal Board comprising of three teachers including the supervisor/ guide. The external examiner will evaluate 80% and the Internal Board will evaluate out 20% of the total marks in such a paper.



General Rules and Regulation:

- Every student of the institution and all intra-institutional bodies shall subject to the general guidance and control as may be prescribed by the college Governing Body from time to time.
- No student shall be admitted to any course of studies if she is found to have indulged in any activity considered detrimental to academic interest of the college.
- A student shall be subject to disciplinary action if she is found disobedient and indecent in her behaviour with the teachers and the college authority.
- A student who is found to have violated college rules shall be liable to expulsion.
- Only recognized bodies shall have the privilege to use the college premises after obtaining formal permission from the principal.
- No notice or leaflets can be circulated anywhere in the college premise without prior approval of the Principal.
- Admission fee and all other fees are to be paid at a time for the whole year on the day of admission.
- Each academic session will run as per the Academic Calendar embodied here.
- Wearing of college uniform is compulsory during college hours on all working days including the days of college week; meetings, examination etc. College uniform will be only single standard.
- Model of college uniform: kamiz to fall upto knee. Loose type salowar.
- The decision of the Principal on all matters relating to students shall be final and binding.

To provide residential facilities to the needy and meritorious student coming from the remote places /areas of the district, the college authority has constructed two well equipped hostels with all modern amenities within the area of the college campus they have a capacity of a hundred students.
