




November

of E-banking and also discussed the Precautionary measures to be taken against various fraudulent activities frequently faced by Bank Customers.








4. 19th November, 2022 " 400th Birth Anniversary of Lachit Borphukan"








Prohibition of Child Marriage act, 2006"
